**THE POLICE**

This series of programmes offers an excellent opportunity of training for Officers, new and experienced.

**ASSAULT ON OFFICERS :**

**ATTITUDE MISTAKES**

18 minutes Rs. 5,310/-

This programme illustrates common attitude errors like treating inmates as inferior human being, taunting them, retaliating for trouble they might have caused and supervising through intimidation. The dramatisation in this programme is of great value.

**ASSAULT ON OFFICERS :**

**TACTICAL MISTAKES**

19 minutes Rs. 5,310/-

This programme dramatises common tactical mistakes that result in Officer injuries and explains clearly the procedures they should follow. It shows them ways of avoiding mistakes such as standing too close to inmates who are out of control, neglecting to check the state of mind of the inmates before opening the doors.

**CELL EXTRACTION**

CORRECTIONAL EMERGENCY RESPONSE TEAM TRAINING

09 minutes Rs. 3,050/-

CERT is a carefully trained group of Officers who handle emergencies within a correctional facility in addition to their regular duties. This

programme details the complex cell entry procedures used to transfer inmate without causing any injuries. It also shows the care involved in the task of a CERT member from the beginning to the appearance of a Health Officer to examine the prisoner.

**CELL SEARCHES**

15 minutes Rs. 4,250/-

Nothing is simple about a cell search if it is done right. Tough questions are asked of experienced Officers to help them determine if they are as systematic and thorough as they think they are.

**COMMUNICATION SKILLS**

17 minutes Rs. 5,090/-

Skills illustrated are listening with interest to the problems of the inmates, exhibiting a willingness to talk, listening without interrupting or dominating the interaction, treating all problems as important and being fair and impartial.

**CON GAMES INMATES PLAY**

22 minutes Rs. 5,240/-

This programme shows the games the inmates play to manipulate Officers. The main protection against con games is good supervision of inmates. Effective techniques of supervision are shown and their specific effects on maintenance of control are discussed at some length.

**DECISION EXERCISES**

24 minutes Rs. 5,090/-

Dramatic vignettes illustrate twenty-one problem situations Correctional Officers face in their daily encounters with inmates. The problems dealt with in this programme are complaints about job assignments, accusations of mistreatment, attempts to make deals with Officers, sexual advances towards Officers and suicide attempts.

**HANDLING AGGRESSIVE INMATES**

22 minutes Rs. 5,830/-

Sooner or later every Officer faces an aggressive inmate. This programme dramatises situations of confrontation in which they were injured. It demonstrates techniques of handling violent inmates, reducing tensions and avoiding injuries. The dramatisation, precise explanation and supporting captions lead to a clear understanding of the subject.

**INMATE MANAGEMENT**

20 minutes Rs. 5,090/-

This programme demonstrates to the Officers methods of dealing with disciplinary problems and managing inmates effectively. It shows ways of maintaining control in difficult situations and yet treat inmates with respect. A good example to create a positive environment are the topics dealt with in this programme.

**IF YOU ARE TAKEN HOSTAGE**

Being taken hostage is a daily risk for Officers. This programme outlines the patterns and stages that most hostage situations follow and it shows life saving survival techniques for Officers.

**INMATE BODY SEARCHES :****PART 1 - CLOTHED BODY SEARCH**17 minutes Rs. 3,950/-

These two programmes illustrate techniques and rules for male and female clothed and unclothed body searches – an area of work that requires highest professional standards. Emphasis is placed on reasons why each aspect of the search is conducted as it is.

**INTERVIEWING TECHNIQUES**

21 minutes Rs. 5,090/-

This programme focuses on effective techniques to get information from inmates. It shows that simply asking for explanations on the spot is of no great help. Effective interviewing requires privacy and time to establish a rapport and keep lines open for communication.

**INTRODUCTION TO CONTRABAND**

12 minutes Rs. 3,125/-

Contraband control calls for imagination applied to both materials and hiding places. This programme illustrates with startling clarity that "if you give the wrong inmate enough time and wrong toys to play with, you will regret it".

**OFFICER OBSERVATION**

13 minutes Rs. 3,025/-

When the instincts of an Officer or his 'vibes' are

properly 'tuned', they can be good tools for control. The experienced Officer would say "you can feel it in the air" whether it be a planned escape, a gang war or other planned disturbances. This programme exemplifies time-tested unusual inmate behaviour that ought to be noticed.

**PRINCIPLES OF DISCIPLINE**

22 minutes Rs. 5,090/-

In this programme, the day-to-day application of the basics of good discipline is shown at length. It tells of the responsibility of the Officers to understand techniques for maintaining discipline and applying them for the good, safety and orderliness of the institution.

**PROBLEM EXERCISES :****STAFF-INMATE RELATIONS**

19 minutes Rs. 5,090/-

A number of problem-situations encountered by Officers are dramatised in this programme. They include an inmate accusing Officers of prejudice and of sexual advances; an Officer observing unusual behaviour of an inmate and an Officer smelling alcohol on the breath of an inmate about to be released.

This programme details the difficult and complex responsibilities of a First Line Supervisor in a correctional facility. Sixteen situations faced by Officers are simulated in detail. This innovative training programme is aimed at improving the problem-solving skills of both new and experienced Officers by showing them the ways they can fine-tune their decision-making skills in the friendly environment of the classroom.

**SECURITY IN A CORRECTIONAL FACILITY**

21 minutes Rs. 5,090/-

Concrete and steel are only a small part of security. It is the knowledge of elements of security and their practice by the Officers that makes an institution secure. This programme encourages them to test their own practices and knowledge as well as their thoroughness.

**SEARCHES**

58 minutes Rs. 5,310/-

This comprehensive programme provides

individualised training and review of search procedures. It helps build the ability of the Officer to recognise contraband and potentially contraband materials. It reinforces their understanding of procedures and routines for searching prisoners (both clothed and unclothed searches) and includes methods of searching cell areas and vehicles.

**STAFF-INMATE RELATIONS : PART 1**  
14 minutes Rs. 3,250/-

**STAFF-INMATE RELATIONS : PART 2**  
13 minutes Rs. 3,250/-

These two programmes demonstrate the give and take in relationships between Staff and inmates. It helps Officers to enhance that cooperation. Self analysis identifies areas for improvement.

**STRESS MANAGEMENT**  
11 minutes Rs. 2,730/-

Correctional work can be very stressful. The video dramatises reasons for stress, shows its symptoms and helps officers take the most important step in stress management: recognising the problem. It also offers techniques for handling stress. Also available in Hindi version at Rs. 3,460/-

**SUPERVISION OF INMATES**  
23 minutes Rs. 5,830/-

A no-nonsense discussion amongst Officers from several institutions of their role. They anticipate problems and offer solutions based on the events of the years of their experience.

**SUPERVISION OF SPECIAL INMATES**  
20 minutes Rs. 5,830/-

Four major psychological disorders and their characteristics are the subject of this programme. It also provides guidelines for understanding special inmates and demonstrates correct procedures for dealing effectively with them.

**TRANSPORTATION OF INMATES : IF YOU ARE TAKEN HOSTAGE**  
10 minutes Rs. 3,960/-

This informative programme deals with the realities of Officers being taken hostage by their prisoners. It illustrates both good and bad tactics used. It discusses the crucial role of the initial actions of the Officer taken hostage; things to

avoid while being held hostage; and the various risks of transporting prisoners and the potential of being taken hostage.

**TRANSPORTATION OF PRISONERS**  
13 minutes Rs. 3,025/-

Transporting prisoners is a rather specialised task. It can be risky for both Officers and inmates if not conducted with thoroughness and safety in mind. The principles for safe transportation are shown in detail in this programme.

## CRIME PREVENTION

**ARMED ROBBERY : PREPARE TO SURVIVE**  
20 minutes Rs. 5,310/-

Any business, irrespective of its size, dealing in cash or commodity can become the target of an armed robbery resulting in injury or death. An important objective of this programme is to enunciate guidelines for robbery prevention. Also available in Hindi version at Rs. 5,750/-

**BASIC SECURITY SUREVEYS**  
24 minutes Rs. 3,640/-

The first step citizens can take in the process of preventing crime is the security survey assessing opportunities for it to be committed at a specific location. Viewers witness surveys in a small retail operation, a tavern and a warehouse and are then asked to solve the security problems uncovered, keeping in mind the theory of risk management.

**BURGALARIES IN PROGRESS : AN ANALYSIS OF OFFICERS KILLED**  
13 minutes Rs. 4,250/-

Re-enactment of the true risks and enunciation of vital statistics give Officers the information they need to survive while on burglary calls. In the past, Officers have been killed by unseen suspects such as lookouts. This programme shows the many ways to die on a burglary call. Awareness of those ways may help keep Officers alive.

**BUSINESS OF CRIME PREVENTION : THE SECURITY SURVEY**  
27 minutes Rs. 4,820/-

This programme is a step-by-step inspection of the three basic lines of defence against crime. It is

fully documented and illustrated with specific suggestions to make the premises less vulnerable. It stresses that efforts to reduce business crime begin with a security survey. Also available in Hindi version at Rs. 5,750/-

**CASE OF NEIGHBOURHOOD WATCH**  
15 minutes Rs. 4,650/-

This programme deals with enlisting help of social cohesion because home security depends on good, solid citizenship of a neighbourhood joined in common interest and goals.

**COCAINE TRAIL**  
25 minutes Rs. 5,880/-

An interesting and thorough examination of the coke problem, this programme shows how and where the drug is grown and manufactured. State, local and law agency strategies for control of trafficking in 'coke', including actual footage of trafficker 'buses' are presented.

**COMPUTER SECURITY**  
22 minutes Rs. 4,650/-

It is not easy to define computer crime but it does constitute theft in every sense of the word. This programme points out that those who work with computer systems have an obligation to preserve the integrity of information that is stored.

**CRACK COCAINE**  
15 minutes Rs. 4,650/-

The three forms of Cocaine-Crack (free base and hydrochloride powdered ones) are described here in terms of their appearance, texture and means of ingestion. Also illustrated are the elements of physical evidence that an Officer should look for in potential charges as well as the paraphernalia to process, package and smoke. **CRIME CHECK : COMPUTER SECURITY**  
18 minutes Rs. 4,650/-

This timely programme demonstrates methods of protecting electronic files, hard drives and floppy disks from theft and accidental loss. It shows ways of avoiding exposure to virus and the proper procedures to follow if the system becomes infected. The programme also gives contacts in case of computer emergency or a total system breakdown due to virus infection.

**CRIME CHECK : BANK ROBBERY**  
29 minutes Rs. 5,350/-

This programme demonstrates to bank employees all aspects of bank robbery confrontations and assorted precautionary measures. Crimes committed by a variety of perpetrators as well as proper response by employees are detailed. Also available in Hindi version at Rs. 6,950/-

**CRIME CHECK : FRAUDS AND SCAMS AGAINST SENIORS**  
22 minutes Rs. 4,650/-

Because of the increasing elderly population there are more fraudulent crimes being committed against senior citizens. This programme identifies ways to spot a scam. Most common forms of fraud committed against elders are illustrated in some detail.

**CRIME CHECK : PERSONAL SECURITY**  
17 minutes Rs. 4,650/-

This programme is designed to assist the average person in recognising and avoiding dangerous confrontations. It demonstrates many helpful safety precautions worthy of application.

**CRIME CHECK : SECURITY PROCEDURES FOR BANK EMPLOYEES**  
17 minutes Rs. 4,650/-

This programme deals with the common criminal activities that occur at financial institutions and shows methods of handling these situations in detail including 'kiting cheques', the manager approval scam, confidence tricks played on customers and bomb threats.

**CRIME : SENIOR ALERT**  
21 minutes Rs. 4,650/-

This programme offers guidelines and safety rules to help senior citizens protect themselves and their property. Frequently perpetrated crimes against them are dramatised. Victims explain why they were vulnerable and describe the precautions they have learnt to take.

**CRIMES IN PROGRESS**

'The action is hot. Your blood is rushing. Your pulse quickens and your adrenaline urges you to

go and get them. You react.' It shows what to do and more importantly what not to do. It contains excellent footage of crimes in progress.

**CRIME IN THE STREETS (2<sup>ND</sup> EDITION)**  
16 minutes Rs. 4,650/-

Angelo, a reformed mugger and thief, takes viewers on a tour of the city. He demonstrates how to 'crimeproof' oneself on the city streets, parking lots, supermarkets, elevators and cars. **CRIME SCENE PRESERVATION**  
18 minutes Rs. 4,650/-

**NEIGHBOURHOOD WATCH**

**OFF-DUTY SURVIVAL**
